

APPLICATIONS:	MINK1 antibody can be used in ELISA, and immunohistochemistry starting at 10 ug/mL.
USER NOTE:	Optimal dilutions for each application to be determined by the researcher.
SPECIFICITY:	BLAST analysis of the peptide immunogen showed no homology with other human proteins.
IMMUNOGEN:	MINK1 antibody was raised against a peptide located near the internal domain of MINK1 (Human).

PURIFICATION:	Immunoaffinity Chromatography
PHYSICAL STATE:	Liquid
BUFFER:	PBS, 0.1% sodium azide.
STORAGE CONDITIONS:	MINK1 antibody should be stored long term (months) at -80 °C and short term (days) at 4 °C. As with all antibodies avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
CLONALITY:	Polyclonal
CONJUGATE:	Unconjugated

BACKGROUND: MINK is a MSN type protein kinase. The protein has a structure similar to other germinal center kinases, and it has been shown to activate the c-Jun N-terminal kinase and p38 pathways.
